


HPSU FOUNDERS FORUM

The HPSU Founders Forum is a peer network of startup founders who challenge and support each other to scale globally. Enterprise Ireland has partnered with Select Strategies to give founders an environment in which they address issues, share challenges, seek support, reflect and learn from each other and from founders who are further along the scaling journey.

Founders meet regularly over a 12-15 month period. They share and tackle their toughest problems using startup best practices and action learning. The Forum also provides opportunities to learn from key experts on international sales, leadership & team, funding & finance and product-market fit through a series of topic-based clinics and guest speakers.

Founders can also enter the annual Founder of the Year competition where nominations are made by peer members.


Who should Join?

Forum Approach

FACILITATED FOUNDER GROUPS

During the 12-15 month journey, founders join a founder group where they share challenges and insights in a trusted and safe environment. A total of nine facilitated founder group sessions are held of which four are self-hosted. These founder groups provide a valuable network beyond the forum journey.

TOPIC-BASED CLINICS

Clinics take place during each forum day and address topics of particular importance to startups. They are a unique opportunity to learn from experts with the conversation in the room led by founder members.

ONE-TO-ONE IMPLEMENTATION SUPPORT

Each founder will receive three one-to-one sessions with their assigned group facilitators who are experienced CEOs of startups themselves. The facilitator will support the founder in leading the business and implementing best practice.

Forum days also include expert speakers on identified topics of interest and interviews with CEO founders who have scaled their business successfully.



Forum Outputs

The Forum provides a unique opportunity for CEO founders to learn from each other in a trusted and safe environment.

Participating in the HPSU Founders Forum will help you to:

- Ensure your product is fit for market, identify your ideal customer, test your assumptions, pivot and get it right.
- Understand cash flow, funding options, investor relations and the importance of the finance function and matching your resources to your growth plan.
- Develop your leadership style as you build out your team, manage conflict and lead your company’s culture.
- Acquire new customers as you build out your international sales process and when and how to hire the right sales team to support your ambitions.

Fees

Membership of the Forum is subsidised by Enterprise Ireland. After applying De Minimis funding of €3,500, the direct cost to company is €875.

Fees include participation at all events and meals. For companies with co-founders who would like to join, an additional fee will apply.

How to join

Membership of the Forum is made as part of your application for HPSU funding investment. Founders will automatically be invited to join following investment approval in January, March, June or October as appropriate.
